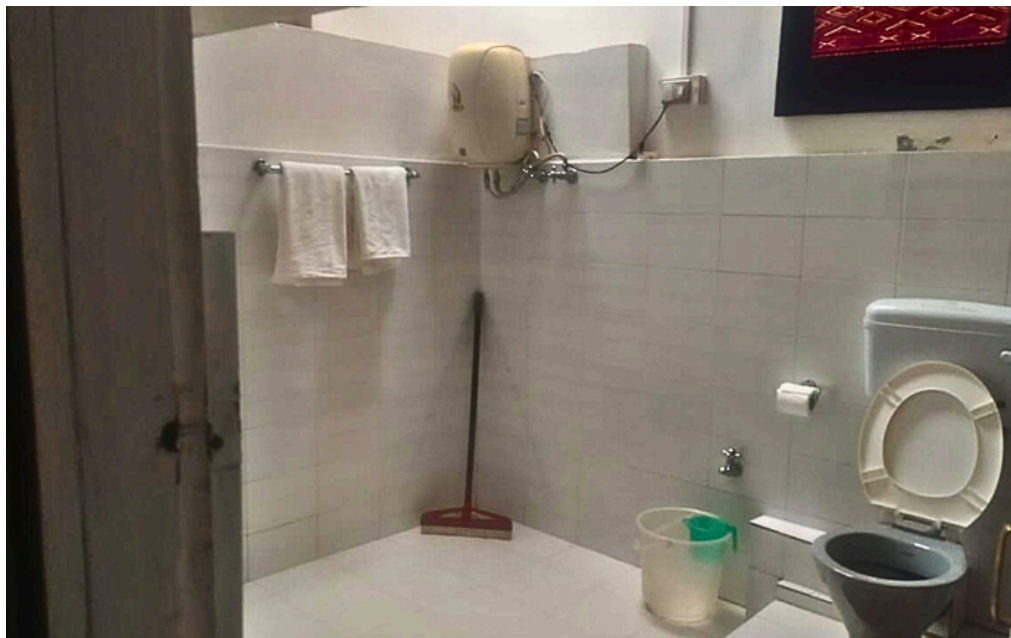
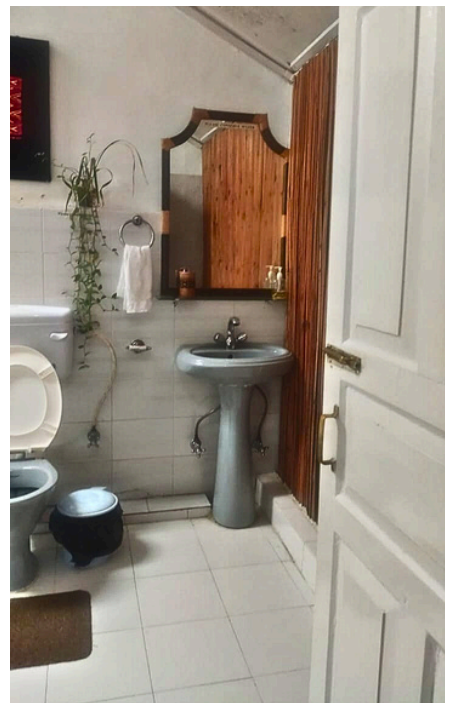
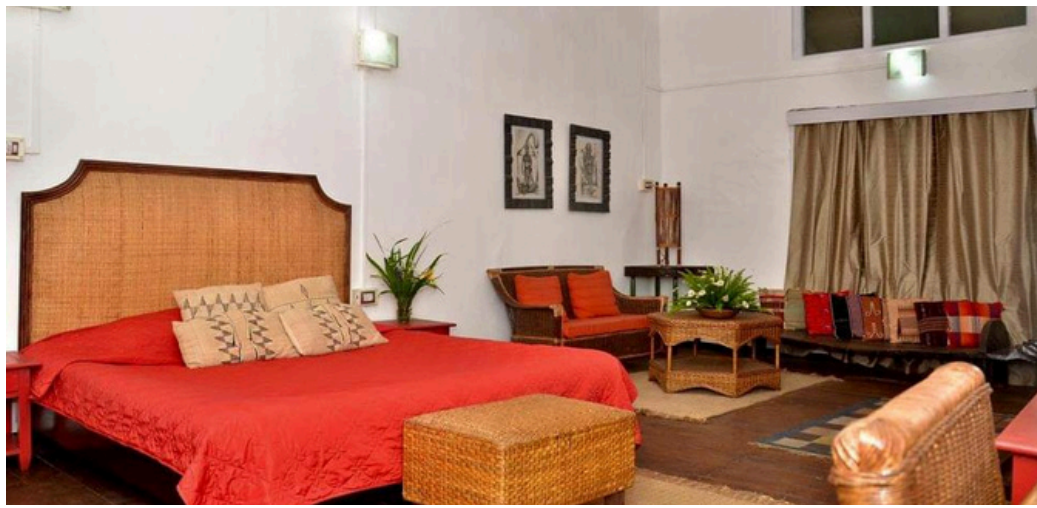
What you can expect -
